Graffiti Hotline:

Concerned citizens can report graffiti on their own, or others property, by calling 427-0462 or 722-7771. It is quick, easy and confidential for the caller. Leave the address, or description of the location of the graffiti. We will contact the property owner and arrange the removal of the graffiti.

Graffiti Removal From Private Property:

Homeowners and business owners who have been the victims of graffiti vandalism can call and request that it be removed from their property free of charge. Owners may even choose the paint color.

Community Paint-outs:

We sponsor community paint-outs regularly. This is a great opportunity for individuals, families and groups to do something great for their neighborhood by volunteering to participate in paint-outs. We organize the event, provide all the equipment and paint, negotiate with property owners, and provide insurance for volunteers. We arrange special projects for groups or classes of all sizes.
